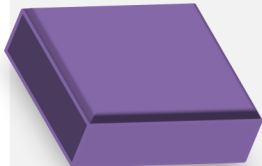

Congratulations on the new arrival

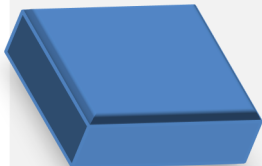

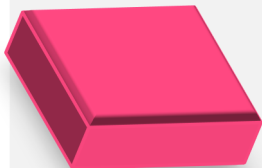


Victorian Government eServices Register

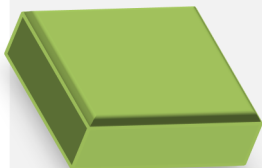

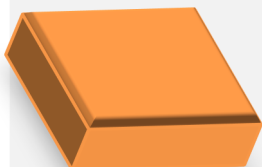
