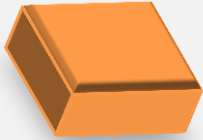

Welcome Ben Hanley

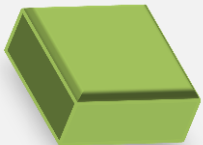

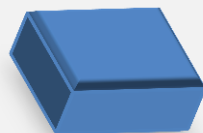
